NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on this date Central Telephone Company of Florida and United Telephone Company of Florida ("Sprint United/Centel" or the "Sprint") filed certain cost studies which were required by Order No. PSC-96-0811-FOF-TP. A portion of the cost studies contains information Sprint believes to be "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 364.183, Florida Statutes (1995), and this information, which is being filed under a confidential cover, consists of 30 pages.

Accordingly, Sprint United/Centel HEREBY GIVES NOTICE OF ITS INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION of certain portions of the cost studies filed as described in this notice. Parties who have signed an appropriate non-disclosure agreement, or who are willing to sign a non-disclosure agreement, may contact the undersigned counsel to obtain a copy of those pages of the studies.

On August 20, 1996, Sprint filed its Motion for an Extension of Time to File Cost Studies and Rates Required by Order No. PSC-96-0811-FOF-TP. These cost studies and rates relate to converting bundled services to unbundled loops.

Sprint United/Centel will file a request for confidential classification covering the cost data described in this notice within twenty-one (21) days as required by Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

In addition, because the cost studies are voluminous, a copy is being served on MFS only, the sole petitioner in this proceeding. Any other party wishing to receive a copy of the studies should contact the undersigned counsel. It should be noted that these cost studies employ TSLRIC methodology and not TELRIC methodology as required by the FCC in its First Report and Order in CC Docket 96-98, issued August 8, 1996. Additionally, given the many proceedings nationwide in which these issues are being debated, it is appropriate to note that this filing does not represent the positions Sprint may take in future proceedings or negotiations.
