
On May 10, 1996, this Commission received an application from Oak Springs Mobile Home Park (Oak Springs or utility) for a landlord-tenant exemption pursuant to Section 367.022(5), Florida Statutes and Rule 25-30.060(3)(e), Florida Administrative Code. The primary contact person for Oak Springs is Mr. Robert Munro, Utilities Director for Chateau Properties. Chateau Properties, Inc. is the owner of Oaks Springs. The mailing address for Chateau Properties and the above contact person is 14205 E. Colonial Drive, Orlando, Florida 32826. The physical address for the utility is 12 Highland Street, Sorrento, Florida 32776. The utility, located in Lake County, will provide water and wastewater service solely to its tenants.

The applicant, operating as a corporation, has filed in accordance with Section 367.022(5), Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-30.060(3)(e), Florida Administrative Code. In addition, the applicant acknowledged Section 837.06, Florida Statutes, regarding false statements. A statement that there are no additional charges for water or wastewater and charges for this service are non-specifically contained in rental charges, was included in the application. Based on the information provided, it is the recommendation of Staff that Oak Springs be granted a certificate of exemption for the utility located at 12 Highland Street, Sorrento, Florida 32776, pursuant to Section 367.021(5), Florida Statutes.

According to Section 2.08(c)(14), Administrative Procedures Manual, Staff has been given administrative authority to approve clear-cut or non-controversial requests for determination of exempt status. Staff recommends that an administrative order be issued as soon as possible finding Oak Springs Mobile Home Park exempt from Commission regulation pursuant to Section 367.022(5), Florida Statutes. Staff further recommends that the order require Oak Springs Mobile Home Park to notify this Commission in the event of any change of circumstances or method of operation of its water
