RE: DOCKET NO. 960903-EI - Complaint of Mrs. Blanca Rodriguez against Florida Power & Light Company regarding alleged current diversion/meter tampering rebilling for estimated usage of electricity.

Issue 1: Recommendation that prima facie evidence of meter tampering noted in FPL's reports, as well as during the informal conference, makes it reasonable to believe that meter tampering occurred at the Rodriguez residence. Since the account was in Mr. Rodriguez' name during the entire period, he should be held responsible for a reasonable amount of backbilling.

Issue 2: Recommendation that Florida Power & Light Company's calculation of the backbilled amount of \$7,453.12 for unmetered electric usage and a \$349.38 investigation charge are reasonable.
