Dear Ms. Gilchrist:

When Bocilla Utilities received the above referenced Order Number issued August 8, 1995, the Utility filed this Order along with the approved tariff.

The only explanation the Utility has for overlooking the monthly reporting requirement of the Gross Up of CIAC is that Bocilla Utilities has only one full time employee, the plant operator. All other work is done either on a volunteer basis by stockholders of the Utility or are paid on a per-item basis, such as the billing.

During the period September 27, 1994, through the present, Bocilla Utilities collected 18 deposits. All of these monies were deposited into an interest bearing escrow account and have been returned each year with the accumulated interest.

Again, the only justification the Utility has for not meeting the monthly reporting requirements is that the requirement was overlooked when the Order was first received and the Utility's customer base of 170 has not been able to generate enough revenue to provide for any office help.

Hopefully the above explanation will be taken into consideration when the Commission considers the Utility's oversight.
