On September 16, 1996, the Commission approved temporary service availability charges for the utility. The approved charges include a plant capacity charge of \$920 and a main extension charge of \$639 for wastewater only. These charges can be charged to new customers only on or after the Commission approved effective date.

A Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order will be issued around October 7, 1996 addressing the Commission's decision. New customers will be allowed 21 days from the issuance date of the PAA Order to protest. If no protests are timely filed with the Commission, new customers have been noticed, and revised tariffs have been received and approved by staff, the new charges will be effective the day after the end of the protest period.
