On March 4, 1996, an application for the transfer of BCD Industries, Inc., to the City of Kissimmee was filed with the Commission pursuant to Section 367,071(4)(a), Florida Statutes. The application was filed by Mr. Thomas E. Chalifoux, Jr. as the president of BCD Industries, Inc. On October 14, 1996, the Commission received the attached joint request from the City of Kissimmee and BCD Industries, Inc., to withdraw the application for transfer because the closing on the contract for sale and purchase has not occurred. The parties have indicated that they will submit another application for transfer at a future date, if applicable.

Section 2.07(C)(6)(d) of the Administrative Procedures Manual grants the Division of Records and Reporting, upon joint recommendation of the OPR division and the Division of Legal Services, the authority to administratively close dockets in which the applicant seeks to withdraw its initial pleading. Staff has determined that there are no pending issues that need to be addressed by the Commission regarding this filing, there was no filing few involved, and no agency action has been taken.
