RE: DOCKET NO. 961040-TC - Petition for waiver of Rules 25-24.515(7) and 25-24.620(2)(c) and (d), F.A.C., regarding 0+ local and 0+ intraLATA traffic, by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (Deferred from the October 8, 1996 Conference due to Tropical Storm Josephine)

Issue 1: Recommendation that the Commission grant BellSouth's petition for exemption from Rule 25-24.515(7), and Rule 25-24.620(2)(c) and (d) F.A.C., and the policies contained in Orders Nos. PSC-95-95-0918-FOF-TP, PSC-95-0203-FOF-TP, and 24101 to permit it to handle and bill 0+ local and 0+ intraLATA calls from pay telephones located in confinement facilities at no more than the rates charged by the serving local exchange company for the same call.

APPROVED

Issue 2: Recommendation that this docket be closed unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's decision files a protest within 21 days of issuance of the proposed agency action order. A protest filed by a local exchange company shall be applicable only to that local exchange company's territory and shall not prevent BellSouth from carrying this traffic in a non-protesting LEC's territory.
