RE: DOCKET NO. 961074-TL - Petition for waiver of Rule 25-24.515(9), F.A.C., to allow concentration of up to a maximum of three instruments to one line for coinless pay telephone services located in confinement facilities, by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.

Issue 1: Recommendation that the Commission grant BellSouth's petition for an exemption from the provisions of Rule 25-24.515(9), F.A.C., and Order No. 14529 which prohibit BellSouth from installing up to three pay telephone instruments per access line in confinement facilities. The exemption should be granted for BellSouth's pay telephones located in confinement facilities only provided there is a concentration of no more than three pay telephone instruments per access line.

*On the Commission's own motion the vote was reconsidered to allow staff additional time to explore this issue.*

Issue 2: Recommendation that this docket be closed unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's decision files a protest within 21 days of the issuance of the proposed agency action order.
