RE: DOCKET NO. ~~88883~~-WS - Application for approval of revised service availability charges in Flagler County by Palm Coast Utility Corporation.

Issue 1: Recommendation that the utility should be allowed to implement the system capacity charge of \$1,500 for water connections. The water tariff sheet filed on December 27, 1995 should be approved as filed. The water system capacity charge should become effective for connections made on or after the stamped approval date of the tariff sheet pursuant to Rule 25-30.475(2), F.A.C. The appropriate wastewater system capacity charge should be \$1,390. Therefore, the wastewater tariff sheet filed on December 27, 1995, should be denied as filed. If the utility files revised tariff sheets within thirty days of the issuance date of the order which are consistent with the Commission's vote, staff should be given administrative authority to approve the revised tariff sheets upon verification that the tariffs are consistent with the Commission's decision. If the revised tariff sheets are filed and approved, the wastewater system capacity charge should become effective for connections made on or after the stamped approval date of the revised tariff sheets.

Issue 2: Recommendation that the docket should be closed upon the utility's timely filing of revised tariffs according to the Commission's order, staff's verification that the tariffs reflect the Commission's order, and if no protests are filed by a substantially affected person within 21 days of the issuance of the order. If any timely protest is filed, the docket should not be closed. If a protest is filed regarding the denial of the proposed wastewater tariff or the Commission's approval of the proposed water tariff, as addressed in Issue No. 1, the utility's proposed tariff may be implemented. If the utility's proposed tariff is implemented then all charges collected under the proposed tariff should be held subject to refund pending resolution of the protest. If a protest is filed regarding the proposed agency action portion of the order as addressed in Issue No. 1, then that portion of the order will be null and void and any revenues collected under the existing tariff should be held subject to refund.
