## **MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

- 1. By Order No. PSC-96-1297-FOF-TI issued October 21, 1996, the Public Service Commission directed LDM Systems, Inc. to show cause why the Company should not be fined for apparent violations of Rule 25-4.118, F.A.C.
