APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF PINEWOOD TRAILER PARK, INC.

STATE OF FLORIDA COUNTY OF VOLUSIA

BEFORE ME, a Notary Public, in and for the State of Florida at Large, personally appeared STANLEY F. SZLOSEK, JR., who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says:

- That PINEWOOD TRAILER PARK, INC. operates a mobile home park in Volusia County, Florida and is currently applying to the Public Service Commission for an exemption from the provisions of Chapter 367, Florida Statutes. The docket number is 960560-WS.
- That the undersigned is the president of the applicant corporation and has the requisite authority to make the representations set forth herein on behalf of the corporation.
- That the City of Daytona Beach, Florida currently provides the applicant's trailer park
 with water and sewer services, and the applicant currently pays the entire monthly bill for the water
 and sewer services provided.
- 4. That applicant seeks reimbursement from each mobile home owner for water and sewer services actually used by said owner. Applicant has, therefore, installed a separate water meter for each mobile home lot in the park to measure actual usage.
- That applicant does not intend, nor has applicant ever intended, to make a profit from the metering of the water. The metering is, rather, to insure accurate reimbursement.
- 6. That in connection with the water and sewer services provided in the park, applicant makes the following representations:
 - a. Applicant will not collect deposits.
 - Applicant will not charge the mobile home owners any miscellaneous service charges.
 - c. There will be no water charges to the individual mobile home owners for water supplied to the mobile home park common areas.
