We request that the pay telephones located at the address below be exempted from the provisions of Rule 25-4.076(6), Florida Administrative Code, which requires that all pay telephone stations must allow incoming calls to be received "with the exception of those located at penal institutions, hospitals and schools and at locations specifically exempted by the Commission." They believe the waiver will restrict the usefulness of the pay telephones for these individuals. This location does not fit within the delineated exceptions to the rule and therefore this request for waiver is appropriate. The location provider for the location identified above has either joined in or agreed to this request for waiver which is attached. The Commission has previously granted a waiver of this Rule in Order No. 23762, issued November 15, 1990, approving Southern Bell's petition for waiver of the rule for pay telephones located at three laundromats owned by Mr. Patrick Collins in Miami, Florida. The owner had requested blocking of incoming calls to restrict the usefulness of the public phone for drug dealers and prostitutes.
