PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF TRANSFER AND MERGER OF CERTIFICATES

United Telephone Company of Florida ("United") and Central Telephone Company of Florida ("Centel") (collectively referred to herein as "Petitioners" or "Companies") file this Petition for Approval of Transfer and Merger of Certificates, and in support of the Petition state:

1. United and Centel are corporations organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida with their principal mailing address at Post Office Box 165000, Altamonte Springs, Florida 32716-5000. United and Centel are telecommunications companies as defined in Section 364.02(7), Florida Statutes (1995), and are subject to jurisdiction of the Florida Public Service Commission.

3. This Petition is filed pursuant to Section 364.345(2), Florida Statutes, which requires approval of the Florida Public Service Commission to sell, assign or transfer a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Section 364.33, Florida Statutes, which requires approval of the acquisition of ownership or control of any telecommunications facility. The accompanying affidavit of Jerry M. Johns is filed pursuant to Section 364.335, Florida Statutes and Rule 25-4.005, F.A.C.

4. Petitioners seek the Commission's approval for the transfer of Centel's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to United and the simultaneous merger of United's and Centel's Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity pursuant to the terms of the Agreement and Plan of Merger ("Plan of Merger") which is attached to this Petition as Exhibit "A".

5. United holds Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 32 which authorizes the provision of telecommunications services in all or parts of the Florida counties of Polk, Okeechobee, Hardee, DeSoto, Highlands, St. Lucie, Palm Beach, Charlotte, Glades, Hendry, Lee, Collier, Monroe, Levy, Marion, Citrus, Sumter, Lake, Hernando, Pasco, Orange, Osceola, Seminole and Volusia. United is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sprint Corporation. The attached Exhibit "B" is a description of United's service area.

6. Centel holds Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 33 (Amended) which authorizes the provision of telecommunications services in all or parts of the Florida counties of Okaloosa, Walton, Holmes, Jackson, Gadsden, Washington, Leon, Wakulla, Jefferson, Madison, Bradford and Clay. Centel is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Central Telephone Company, which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Centel Corporation

which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sprint Corporation. The attached Exhibit "C" is a description of Centel's service area.

7. In March 1993, United and Centel came under common ownership as the result of a merger of Sprint Corporation and Centel Corporation. The companies are operated under common management for efficient utilization of physical and human resources.

This Petition is being filed to effect the legal merger of United and Centel.

8. The merger will allow greater efficiencies for the Companies, as well as for those who must interact with the Companies. For example, each of the Companies must maintain its own books and records because each company has separate legal and fiscal requirements which must be observed. If the merger is completed, a single set of books and records can be maintained. Similarly, annual and periodic financial reports must be prepared separately for each company. If the merger is completed, one financial report can be prepared for the merged company. Even everyday functions are impacted by operating as two legal entities: separate contracts are maintained with the same vendors to provide goods and services in common to both companies.

The inefficiency that is unavoidable as a result of doing the same tasks twice adversely affects not only United and Centel. Auditors sent by the Public Service Commission, the Internal Revenue Service, the Florida Department of Revenue, Ernst & Young, LLP, (the companies' outside auditors), and other telecommunications companies, as well as internal auditors, must review two separate sets of books and records even though operationally the same personnel prepare and maintain the records of both companies. Costs and expense must

be allocated between the two companies based on affiliate transaction rules and the companies' Cost Allocation Manuals.

United and Centel have now reached the point where the functional consolidation that has taken place must be accompanied by consolidation as a matter of law. The organization's corporate structure must be changed to be consonant with its functional structure in order to achieve the efficiencies and economies that are possible from such a change. These efficiencies and economies can be gained through a formal merger of United and Centel.

It is in the public interest for telecommunications companies to be operated efficiently and without unnecessary duplication of effort.

9. The merger will require the transfer of Centel's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity which must be approved by the Public Service Commission. Section 364.345(2), Florida Statutes, provides that Commission approval is necessary for the transfer by a telecommunications company of its certificate of public convenience and necessity.

10. The merger of United's and Centel's Certificates also requires Commission approval. Section 364.33, Florida Statutes, provides that Commission approval is necessary when a person acquires ownership or control of a telecommunications facility. United's acquisition of control of Centel through merger constitutes such an event.

11. United and Centel have prepared a formal Plan of Merger which provides for the merger of Centel into United and the change of the surviving corporation's name to Sprint-Florida, Incorporated. United and Centel request the prompt approval of this Petition in order that they may consummate the Plan of Merger by December 31, 1996.

12. As of October 31, 1996, United had 1,408,023 access lines in service; Centel had 377,562. Pending (i.e., held) applications for service as of September 30, 1996, the most current date for which information is available, were five for United and 22 for Centel.

13. The transfer and merging of the Certificates will result in no direct change in the customer operations or services provided by the Petitioners. None of Petitioners' rates or charges have been proposed to be changed by the Petition.

14. The savings to United and Centel, their customers, the Public Service Commission and other interested parties will stem from the elimination of the time, effort and expense associated with performing duplicative functions.

15. The costs of the transfer and merger are not anticipated to be great and in any event will be largely non-recurring in nature. Recording fees, intangible taxes and documentary stamp taxes represent the largest portion of such non-recurring costs. One time trustees' fees and bondholders' representation charges are also anticipated. In the aggregate, these are not expected to be material. These costs will not impact the rates or charges of United or Centel to their respective customers. Petitioners believe that this merger will be transparent to customers aside from the benefit of eliminating any customer confusion associated with the use of separate corporate identities today.

Wherefore, United and Centel request:

A. That the Florida Public Service Commission find that the transfer of Centel's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to United and the simultaneous merger of the Certificates of United and Centel are in the public interest.



C. The merging of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 33 (Amended) held by Central Telephone Company of Florida into the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 33 held by United Telephone Company of Florida;

D. Approval to change the name under which Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 33 is held from United Telephone Company of Florida to Sprint-Florida, Incorporated.



AGREEMENT AND PLAN OF MERGER

This Agreement and Plan of Merger, dated as of the _____ day of _____, 1996, is entered into by and between United Telephone Company of Florida ("United") and Central Telephone Company of Florida ("Centel"), Florida corporations, sometimes jointly referred to as the Constituent Corporations.

WHEREAS, as of the date of this Agreement and Plan of Merger, all of the outstanding Common Stock of United is owned by Sprint Corporation ("Sprint"), a Kansas corporation, and, at the effective time of the merger, all of the Common Stock of United will be owned by Central Telephone Company, a Delaware corporation ("CTC"), which is a subsidiary of Centel Corporation, a Kansas corporation, which in turn is a subsidiary of Sprint; and

WHEREAS, all of the outstanding Common Stock of Centel is owned by CTC; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Constituent Corporations have deemed it advisable and in the best interests of their Shareholder that Centel be merged into United; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of an Agreement and Plan of Merger by the respective Board of Directors and Shareholder of the Constituent Corporations is required by the Florida Business Corporation Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Plan of Merger. In accordance with the Florida Business Corporation Act, Centel shall be merged with and into United which shall be the Surviving Corporation. The name of the Surviving Corporation shall be "Sprint-Florida, Incorporated." The Articles of Incorporation of United shall be amended by reason of the merger as set forth in Section 6 of this Agreement and, as so amended, shall be the Articles of Incorporation of the Surviving Corporation. The Bylaws of United shall be amended by reason of the merger as set forth in Section 6 of this Agreement and, as so amended, shall be the Bylaws of the Surviving Corporation.

2. Effective Date of Merger. At such time following the fulfillment of the conditions precedent set forth in Section 7 of this Agreement as the parties hereto may agree, the Constituent Corporations shall deliver Articles of Merger to the Department of State of the State of Florida pursuant to Section 607.1105 of the Florida Business Corporation Act, and if the Department of State finds that the Articles conform to law and all taxes or fees have been paid, it will file them. As further provided in Section 607.1101 of said Act the merger shall be effective on December 31, 1996 immediately following the transfer of the Common Stock of United to CTC. Such date is designated the "Effective Date."

3. Outstanding Shares. The number of shares of capital stock of each Constituent Corporation outstanding on September 30, 1996 is as follows:

- (a) United: 6,500,000 shares of Common Stock, par value \$2.50.
- (b) Centel: 10 shares of Common Stock, no par value.

4. Payment for Shares. The manner and basis of converting the shares of capital stock of each of the Constituent Corporations shall be as follows:

(a) Each share of the Common Stock, par value \$2.50, of United which shall be outstanding on the Effective Date shall not be changed by reason of the merger and shall continue to be one share of Common Stock, par value \$2.50, of the Surviving Corporation.

(b) Each share of the Common Stock, no par value, of Centel which shall be outstanding on the Effective Date shall be canceled.

5. Effect of Merger. On the Effective Date, the separate existence of Centel shall cease, and United, as the Surviving Corporation, shall succeed to all property, real, personal and mixed, and franchises of each of the Constituent Corporations, as well as all debts due on whatever account to each of them, and thenceforth be responsible for all the liabilities and obligations of each of them, all as provided in Section 607.1106 of the Florida Business Corporation Act. At and after the Effective Date, the assets and liabilities of the Constituent Corporations shall be carried on the books of the Surviving Corporation at the amounts at which they were carried on the books of the Constituent Corporations immediately prior to the merger, and the capital surplus and earned surplus of the Surviving Corporation shall be the sum of the respective surpluses of the Constituent Corporations, subject to such adjustments, eliminations or transfers as required to give effect to the merger contemplated by this Agreement.

6. Amendment of Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. On the Effective Date, the Articles of Incorporation of United shall be amended in their entirety to read as set forth in Exhibit 1 hereto.

On the Effective Date, Section 66 of the Bylaws of United shall be amended to read as follows:

66. The corporate seal shall have inscribed thereon: "Sprint-Florida, Incorporated. Corporate Seal."

7. Conditions Precedent to the Merger. The obligations of United and Centel to effect the merger in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement are subject to the conditions that:

(a) CTC, as shareholder of each of the Constituent Corporations, shall have approved this Agreement.

(b) United and Centel shall have received all necessary approvals from regulatory agencies or other governmental bodies having jurisdiction over the transactions contemplated hereby and each shall have obtained all other required consents and approvals.

8. Termination. This Agreement may be terminated and the transactions contemplated hereby may be abandoned at any time prior to the Effective Date by mutual agreement of the Boards of Directors of the Constituent Corporations, in which event all obligations of the Constituent Corporations hereunder shall terminate without liability on the part of any party.

9. Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and all such counterparts together shall constitute but one and the same instrument.

RESTATED
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SPRINT-FLORIDA, INCORPORATED

Sprint-Florida, Incorporated, whose Articles of Incorporation were filed by the Florida Department of State under the name of United Telephone Company of Florida, does hereby amend and restate its Articles of Incorporation by filing the following Restated Articles of Incorporation, pursuant to Section 607.1007 of the Florida Business Corporation Act. The Restated Articles of Incorporation change the name of the Corporation from United Telephone Company of Florida to Sprint-Florida, Incorporated.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be:

SPRINT-FLORIDA, INCORPORATED.

ARTICLE II - PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business of this Corporation shall be Apopka, Orange County, Florida, but it may establish offices and agencies in any place or places in or out of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE AND GENERAL POWERS

The general purpose of this Corporation shall be the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida Business Corporation Act, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"). This Corporation

shall have all the powers enumerated in the Act and all such powers as are not specifically prohibited to corporations for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

(a) Amount and Designation - The aggregate number of shares which this Corporation shall have authority to issue is 16,000,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$2.50 per share, which shall be designated "Common Stock."

(b) Voting Rights of Stockholders - At each meeting of the stockholders, every holder of Common Stock shall be entitled to cast one vote, on each matter on which stockholders of record shall be entitled to vote, for each share of such stock standing in such holder's name on the record books of the Corporation on the record date fixed for the determination of stockholders entitled to vote at such meeting. Such holders shall vote together on all such matters and not by classes or series, except when and as may be otherwise required by law or these Articles of Incorporation.

(c) Payment for Common Stock - All or any of the Common Stock of the Corporation, if sold, may be paid for in cash, but may also be paid for in property, labor or services at a just valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors at a meeting called for that purpose. Property, labor or services may also be purchased or paid for with Common Stock at a just valuation of such property, labor or services, to be fixed by the Board of Directors of the Corporation at a meeting called for such purpose. In no event shall such just valuation be less than par value.

(d) No Preemptive Rights - No holders of shares of any class of the capital stock of the Corporation shall have as a matter of right any preemptive or preferential

right to subscribe for, purchase, receive or otherwise acquire any part of any new or additional issue of stock of any class, whether now or hereafter authorized, or any bonds, debentures, notes, or other securities of the Corporation, whether or not convertible into shares of stock of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V - TERM

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI - REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the registered office of the Corporation shall be 555 Lake Border Drive, Apopka, Florida 32703, and the registered agent of the Corporation at such address shall be JERRY M. JOHNS. The Corporation may change its registered agent or the location of its registered office, from time to time, without amendment to these Restated Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE VII - BUSINESS

The business of this Corporation shall be conducted by the Board of Directors and by the following officers: Chairman of the Board, President, one or more Vice Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer, and Controller. The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than five nor more than eleven persons. The number of directors may be changed from time to time through the bylaws, but shall never be less than five. More than one office may be held by one and the same person. The Board of Directors may appoint an Executive Committee and such other committees and officers of the Corporation, having such powers, duties and terms of office as such Board of Directors may deem advisable, and as may be provided by the bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII - AMENDMENT

This Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment thereto, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.

CERTIFICATE

The foregoing Restated Articles of Incorporation were duly adopted by the Board of Directors of the Corporation in accordance with the Act on November 12, 1996, and by the holders of the shares of common stock, being the sole shares entitled to vote thereon, on _____, 1996, and the number of votes cast for the foregoing Restated Articles of Incorporation was sufficient for approval by such holders of common stock.
