The Application or Declaration, as heretofore amended and restated by Amendment No. 2, is now further amended in the following respects:

 The final sentence in the next to last paragraph of Item 1.2 of said Amendment No. 2 is amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

"The Applicants represent that they will not, without the further order of the Commission, (i) seek to broker or market other energy commodities to any customer except in conjunction with making electricity sales, (ii) make any sales of such other energy commodities to customers located outside the United States, or (iii) invest in any assets the ownership of which would result in any Operating Company becoming a "gas utility company," as defined under the Act. In addition, the Applicants represent that they will not make any sales of natural gas to retail customers in any State unless authorized or permitted to make such sales under applicable State laws or regulations. 1"

 The first paragraph of Item 3 - <u>Applicable Statutory Provisions</u>, is amended by adding the following additional sentences thereto:

"It is the Applicants' understanding that the staff of the Division of Investment Management does not believe that the Commission has jurisdiction over power marketing activities by domestic electric utility subsidiaries of a registered holding company (or by a service company as agent therefor) if such activities are confined to transactions taking place within the United States. Accordingly, the Applicants represent that, without first obtaining the approval of the Commission, they will not engage in power marketing activities in transactions outside the United States."
