I spoke with Raj Agarwal regarding the fictitious name registration for Sun Communities and he suggested I notify the Commission in writing that Sun Communities will be filing a fictitious name registration after the transfer application is approved.

Regarding the other information Indy Walker requested, we have been able to determine that not all the facilities have been built to serve 2,000 customers. Also, the treatment plant does not have sufficient capacity to serve 2,000 customers. No major additions to plan have been made since the mid-to-late 80s.
