When they were resubmitted, they were given the above ~~Docket #961465-TC~~ by mistake. For this reason, I'm requesting that this Docket #961465-TC be closed.

If a Docket Number is issued to a Request to Block Incoming Calls form when it's submitted and it's incorrect, I will put the docket number at the top of the form. Maybe this will alleviate THIS problem.

The main problem with the forms is that they don't have the Sheriff's or Chief of Police's signature and they can not be processed with any other signature. (Chief of Patrol, Undersheriff, Deputy Major, etc., are not acceptable.) Kay and I had discussed maybe just having the forms sent to me before issuing a docket number to see if they are correct.
