WorldCom, Inc. d/b/a LDDS WorldCom ("WorldCom") and MFS Communications Company, Inc. ("MFSCC"), (collectively the "Applicants"), by their attorneys, hereby notify the Florida Public Service Commission that on December 31, 1996, control of MFSCC was transferred to WorldCom pursuant to the Commission's Order No. PSC-96-1481-FOF-TP in Docket No. 961039-TP, dated December 4, 1996. MFSCC is now a wholly-owned subsidiary of WorldCom.

In the Application in the above-referenced proceeding, the Applicants indicated that upon consummation of the transfer of control, the trade name of WorldCom would change from "LDDS WorldCom" to "MFS WorldCom." WorldCom respectfully advises the Commission that WorldCom presently intends to continue to operate in Florida as "WorldCom, Inc. d/b/a LDDS WorldCom." In the event WorldCom seeks to change this name, WorldCom will communicate with the Commission as necessary.

It is the Applicants' understanding that no further action is required to notify the Commission of the completion of the transfer of control of MFSCC to WorldCom. If this understanding is incorrect, please contact the undersigned as soon as possible.
