Tampa Electric's Statement of Basic Position:

The Commission should determine that Tampa Electric has properly calculated its conservation cost recovery true-up and projections and that the appropriate conservation cost recovery

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factor to be applied by Tampa Electric during the period April 1, 1997 through March 31, 1998 is 0.008 cents per KWH for Interruptible, 0.163 cents per KWH for Residential, 0.159 cents per KWH for General Service Non-Demand and Temporary Service, 0.133 cents per KWH for General Service Demand and Electric Vehicle - Experimental - Secondary, 0.132 cents per KWH for General Service Demand and Electric Vehicle - Experimental - Primary, 0.124 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby - Secondary, 0.123 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby - Primary, 0.121 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby - Subtransmission, and 0.063 cents per KWH for Lighting.
