
To Whom it May Concern:

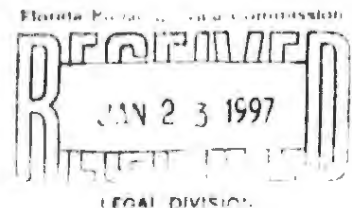
We are attempting to rebuild at this time. One of the requirements for rebuilding will be connecting to public water, either from Manatee County or the City of Bradenton.

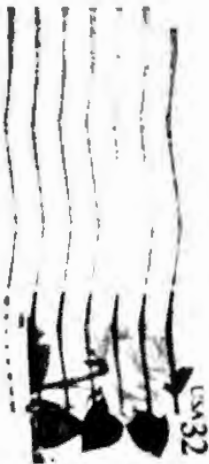
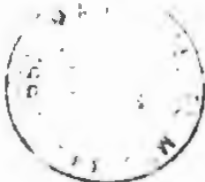
