10. PROPOSED NUMBER OF PAY TELEPHONE INSTRUMENTS THE APPLICANT PLANS TO PLACE IN THE FIRST YEAR:

At this time, Gateway Technologies, Inc. has no specific location where it plans to install service. The Company's business plans call for it to respond to requests for proposals (RFPs) from various city, county and state agencies seeking to install telecommunications services for their inmate populations. Gateway files this application in order to be prepared to offer service should it respond and win a bid from an institution within the state of Florida. The actual number of telephone instruments installed at any given location will vary based on the size of the institution served, the number of prisoners, and type of inmate calling privileges, all of which are site specific.

Call processing equipment installed at prisons or confinement institutions is equipped with remote on-line diagnostics. This capability allows the company's in-house technicians to communicate via dial up data modem with each system at any correctional facility. Gateway Technologies, Inc. can troubleshoot and effect many operational changes to a system without having to be on site.

On-site repairs, such as replacement of telephone instruments or handsets, are performed by a local telecommunications firm chosen by Gateway. This subcontractor is carefully selected based on its technical expertise and ability to respond to trouble calls. To date, no subcontractor has been chosen for Florida.

Gateway relies on the technical expertise of its underlying carrier and serving local exchange carrier for maintenance and administration of its long distance network and the local facilities used for transmission of calls.
