Issue 1: Recommendation that the Commission find that meter tampering occurred at the residence at 301 N.E. 5th Court, Dania, Florida. FPL's reports provide prima facie evidence of meter tampering. As the customer of record during the entire period, Mr. Hart is responsible for a reasonable amount of backbilling.
