Issue 1: Recommendation that the Commission grant Security's petition for exemption from Rules 25-24.515(7), and 25-24.620(2)(c) and (d) F.A.C., and the policies contained in Orders Nos. PSC-95-0918-FOF-TP, PSC-95-0203-FOF-TP, and 24101 to permit it to handle and bill 0+ local and 0+ intraLATA calls from pay telephones located in confinement facilities at no more than the rates charged by the serving local exchange company for the same call.
