Issue 2: Recommendation that the water rates should be a base facility charge of \$20.73 per quarter and usage rate of \$1.28 per 1,000 gallons for a 5/8" x 3/4" meter as outlined in the stipulation. Other meter size rates are outlined in the analysis portion of staff's January 23, 1997 memorandum. The approved rates should be effective for service rendered on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff sheet pursuant to Rule 25-30.475(1), F.A.C. The rates should not be implemented until proper notice has been received by the customers. The utility should provide proof of the date notice was given within 10 days after the date of the notice.

Issue 3: Recommendation that, pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, the parties accepted PAA Order No. PSC-96-1126-FOF-WS, with very limited exceptions, none of which made any provision for a refund. Therefore, the utility should no longer be required to maintain a letter of credit.
