I apologize for the delay in responding to your inquiry regarding the legal description of the area set forth in the Grandfather Certificate Application of Cypress Lakes Associates, Ltd. (Cypress Lakes). As we discussed on the phone, this legal description encompasses the entire approved area which is being developed as the Cypress Lakes manufactured home community.

As you can see from the attached documents, this same area was requested in the application of Cypress Lakes Regional Utility, L.C. dated January 11, 1995, for issuance of a Water and Wastewater Franchise. Paragraph Three of the application indicates that the territory contains approximately 803 acres and is more particularly described on Exhibit "B". I have attached Exhibit "B" and you will note the legal description of the property is the same as that requested in the Grandfather Certificate Application.

I have further enclosed a copy of the letter that James Ade, the attorney who represented Cypress Lakes Regional Utility, L.C., wrote to Ms. Paula Zwack, the Fiscal and Franchise Manager of the Polk County Utility Division, which indicates that Mr. Ade was filing the Water and Wastewater Tariffs as requested by Ms. Zwack. I have attached the first six pages of both the Water and Wastewater Tariffs which were filed. You will note that the Original Sheets 3.1 and 3.2 of both Tariffs contain the same legal description as Exhibit "B" and the same legal description of the area requested by the Grandfather Certificate Application.

I did not send you all 48 pages of the Water Tariff or the 55 pages of the Wastewater Tariff because I felt that the other pages do not address this specific issue. The original application with attachments was in excess of 150 pages. Again, additional attachments in the application other than the application itself and Exhibit "B" did not address the requested area question, therefore, I did not wish to burden you with unnecessary and outdated information

Finally, I am enclosing a copy of two pages of the meeting minutes of the Board of County Commissioners of Polk County wherein they recognized the name change from the original applicant/owner, Cypress Lakes Regional Utility, L.C., to the current owner, Cypress Lakes Associates, Ltd.

### APPLICATION OF CYPRESS LAKES REGIONAL UTILITY, L.C. FOR ISSUANCE OF WATER AND WASTEWATER FRANCHISE

Cypress Lakes Regional Utility, L.C., a limited liability company organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Applicant"), hereby makes application to the Polk County Utilities Commission (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Commission"), for the issuance to Applicant of a Water and Wastewater Franchise (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Franchise"), to serve certain territory in Polk County, Florida, and submits the following information:

1. The name and address of the Applicant are:

The fiscal year of Applicant is January 1 to December 31. See Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

- Applicant is a limited liability company organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida.
- 3. The territory which Applicant ultimately intends to provide with water and wastewater services (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Territory") contains approximately 803 acres in

- the unincorporated area of Polk County, Florida, and is more particularly described on Exhibit "B" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 4. There are no water or wastewater systems within geographical proximity to the Territory from which water or wastewater services can be obtained for the Territory.
- 5. Since the commencement of the development of the Territory in 1987, the Territory has been owned by Cypress Lakes Venture, a partnership organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Venture"). Water and wastewater services have been provided to the Territory by Venture. Venture has not been required to obtain a franchise from the Polk County Utilities Commission for the operation of its water and wastewater systems because heretofore Venture has owned and operated a mobile home park in the Territory and originally provided water and wastewater utility services solely in connection with service to its guests.
- 6. Upon approval of this Application and issuance of a water and sewer franchise to Applicant, certain of the assets of Venture used in the operation of its water and wastewater systems will be transferred or leased to Applicant. The water and wastewater systems currently owned by Venture are hereinafter sometimes referred to as the systems of Venture and sometimes referred to as the systems of Applicant.
- 7. Applicant has available to it personnel who have the qualifications, experience and expertise to operate and manage the

water and wastewater systems of Applicant and to permit Applicant to provide water and wastewater service to the Territory.

- 8. Venture has developed a portion of its mobile home park into lots for sale to residents who will own and occupy their own mobile home lots and units.
- 9. Applicant desires to provide water and wastewater services to individual mobile home lot owners for their use and to Venture for its use in serving its guests.
- 10. Because Venture originally provided water and wastewater services to its mobile home park solely in connection with service to its guests, heretofore no separate charges have been made for water and wastewater service. Applicant proposes to charge its customers the water and wastewater service charges set forth in Section 1 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 11. Venture heretofore has not charged and Applicant proposes not to charge connection fees, capacity fees or line extension charges for water and wastewater services provided by Applicant. See Section 2 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 12. As of September 30, 1994, Venture provided water and wastewater services to six hundred seventy-nine (679) residential customers and five (5) commercial customers. As of said date, Venture provided service to no water-only and to no wastewater-only customers. Because the water and wastewater services are provided by Venture solely in connection with service to its guests, no

- individual water meters are utilized. See Section 3 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 13. The water treatment plant and wastewater treatment plant of Venture have design capacities of 0.284 and 0.160 million gallons per day (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "mgd"), respectively. See Section 4 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 14. Because Venture originally provided water and wastewater services to its mobile home park solely in connection with service to its guests, heretofore no separate charges have been made for extensions of lines, discontinuance of service, disconnection or reconnection of service or tardy payment and no deposits have been collected. Applicant's proposed policies or procedures covering such matters are set forth in Section 5 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 15. The volume of water treated and pumped to guests of Venture and the volume of wastewater treated by Venture for each month from January 1993 through September 1994 are set forth in Section 6 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 16. Profit and Loss Statements for Venture's utility operations for the years ended December 31, 1992, and December 31, 1993, and for the nine month period ended September 30, 1994, are set forth in Section 7 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 17. Balance sheets for Venture's utility operations as of December 31, 1992, December 31, 1993, and September 30, 1994,

including depreciation schedules for all assets, are set forth in Section 8 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. All assets described on the September 30, 1994, Balance Sheet will be purchased by Applicant.

- 18. Additional information or material Applicant deems relevant to the request is set forth in Section 9 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 19. The debt and equity structure of Venture's utility operations as of September 30, 1994, is set forth in Section 10 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 20. Copies of facility maps for the water facilities and wastewater facilities of Venture are set forth in Section 11 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 21. The construction and material specifications for the water and wastewater systems of Venture are set forth in Section 12 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 22. The facility design data for the water and wastewater systems of Venture, including well information, storage capacities, system capacity, pumping data, system operating pressures, line sizing and design calculations, are set forth in Section 13 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 23. Operating permits for the water and wastewater systems of Venture are set forth in Section 14 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 24. Information concerning the contract operator of the water and wastewater systems of Venture, including the name, class and

license of the operator, is set forth in Section 15 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

- 25. Signed and certified copies of United States Income Tax Returns filed with the Internal Revenue Service by Venture for 1992 and 1993 will be made available to the Commission for review upon request by the Commission. The United States Income Tax Return for Venture for 1994 has not been completed or filed with the Internal Revenue Service. A copy of the 1994 Income Tax Return will be made available to the Commission for review upon request by the Commission after it has been completed and filed with the Internal Revenue Service. See Section 16 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 26. Copies of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Drinking Water Treatment Plant Daily Operation Summary forms for the water treatment plant of Venture and the Domestic Wastewater Treatment Plant Monthly Operating Report for the wastewater treatment plant of Venture for February 1992 through September 1994 are set forth in Section 17 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 27. Copies of the most recent inspection reports for inspections made by the regulatory agencies of the water system and the wastewater system of Venture are set forth in Section 18 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, Applicant hereby requests that the Commission:

(a) Exercise its jurisdiction in connection with this matter, cause to be published all necessary notices and schedules

and conduct a public hearing concerning this matter in accordance with the requirements of the Polk County Water and Sewer System Regulatory Ordinance.

- (b) Issue a water and wastewater franchise to Applicant for the territory described in Exhibit "B" attached hereto.
- (c) Approve the water and wastewater service rates and charges set forth in Sections 1, 2 and 5 attached hereto.
- (d) Take such other actions as may be necessary or desirable concerning this matter.
