Dear Commissioner Cleric

I am writing in regard to the Public Service Commission's recent decision to change the area codes for North Florida and to essign a new sees code to the Jacksomille area. I respectfully request that the PSC reconsider this decision and reopen the metter for further discussion in light of the evidence that can be marshaled on behalf of relaining the 904 area code for the Jacksonville area.

As the largest city, largest economy, largest port and primary business center of North Florida, a change of area codes will be a substantial disadventage to the economic progress of Jacksonville, which depends more heavily than other North Florida cities on interestee and international phone calls to transact business in its multi-billion dollar economy. The disruption caused by the changeover, particularly with regard to our many companies doing trusiness with Latin America, Europe and the For East where language barriers may make notification about the changed area code difficult, will be extremely costly.

Within the past year we calebrated the growth of the Jacksonville metropolitan statistical area past the one million mark in population. We are the primary business, trade, distribution and medical center for North Florida. Our companies do more business overseas than other North Florida cities. For these and other reasons that we would like to bring to your ettention, a change of area codes will be a significant detriment to the Jacksonville area and will work a greater hardship on Northeast Florida than would be the case in other parts of the state.

I would very much appreciate having the opportunity to present relevant evidence for your consideration, and ask the Public Service Commission to reconsider this decision. Picase let me hear from you as soon as possible regarding possible reconsideration of this item.
