NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION
ORDER CANCELLING AND GRANTING CERTIFICATES
TO PROVIDE PAY TELEPHONE SERVICE

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are adversely affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

By letter dated December 9, 1991, Michael P. MacPherson requested that Certificate No. 2868 be transferred to Dominion Telephone, Inc. d/b/a Dominion Telephone (Dominion). Because the Commission no longer permits the transfer of certificates, Mr. MacPherson has requested that Certificate No. 2868 be cancelled and a similar certificate be granted to Dominion. Dominion has complied with all prescribed requirements to provide pay telephone service statewide.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 2868 held by Michael P. MacPherson be cancelled. It is further

ORDERED that a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide pay telephone service be granted to Dominion Telephone, Inc. d/b/a Dominion Telephone. It is further

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ORDERED that the Certificate, if granted, shall become effective at the end of the protest period if no objections are filed. It is further

ORDERED that if no objections are filed during the protest period, this docket shall be closed.
