

Mr. Vanderpol acted as Chief Executive Officer for Teledial. In 1986, he formed Digital Signal, a Southfield, Michigan company reselling private line services. Mr. Vanderpol held the position of Chief Executive Officer of the company. In 1988, Mr. Vanderpool formed City Signal, a provider of competitive access and local exchange services in a number of major metropolitan areas, including Grand Rapids, Michigan, Lansing, Michigan, Detroit, Michigan, Holland, Michigan, Las Vegas, Nevada, Memphis, Tennessee, and Nashville, Tennessee. Mr. Vanderpol went on to found Teledial America of North Carolina, a provider of long distance services, in 1990. One year later, he formed ATS Long Distance, also an interexchange carrier.

#### **Richard Postma, Chief Operating Officer**

Richard Postma was graduated from Calvin College in 1973 and received a law degree, cum laude, from the University of Michigan in 1975. Mr. Postma has acted as General Counsel to Teledial America/US Signal and City Signal since in 1985. Mr. Postma has also engaged in corporate law practice for numerous publicly traded and privately held companies throughout the Midwest.

David J. Easter has considerable technical and managerial experience in all facets of the telecommunications industry. 
