BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification.

1. On December 31, 1996, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered its Order No. PSC-96-1579-FOF-PC on Petition for Arbitration. This Order required the filing within 60 days by BellSouth of certain Total Service Long Run Incremental Costs (TSLRIC) cost studies. BellSouth is filing on this date, the above-described, required documents.

2. The information contained in these documents is proprietary to BellSouth and includes, among other things, cost information. This information is clearly

confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Section 364.183 and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

3. Because this information contains proprietary information, BellSouth is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, in order to allow the Commission to take possession of the cost studies without delay. 
