PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing shall be to permit Gulf Power Company and Gulf Coast Electric Cooperative, Inc. to present its testimony and exhibits addressing the territorial dispute between the utilities in South Washington and Bay Counties where the utilities' facilities are commingled and in close proximity; to permit any intervenors to present testimony and exhibits concerning this matter; and for such other purposes as the Commission may deem appropriate. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony. The proceedings will be governed by the provisions of Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 25-22, Florida Administrative Code.
