Issue 1: Based on the results of the survey, should the Wide Waters subdivision be moved from the Stuart exchange into the Port St. Lucie exchange?

Recommendation: No. Since the survey did not meet the requirements of Order No. PSC-96-1501-POF-TL, the BellSouth petition should be denied, and service to the Wide Waters subdivision should remain unchanged.
