CASE BACKGROUND

Certificate number 4482 was issued to Doretta L. Miller January 20, 1996. Certificate number 4668 was issued to Lorie Shearer & Sharon Anderson July 13, 1996. Certificate number 4363 was issued to John Collard January 6, 1996.

The Fiscal Division received payment of Regulatory Assessment Fees and a request for cancellation of the above certificates. Doretta Miller's request and Regulatory Assessment Fee was received December 22, 1996. Lorie Shearer and Sharon Anderson's request and Regulatory Assessment Fee was received December 13, 1996. John Collard's request for cancellation and Regulatory Assessment Fee payment was received on December 17, 1996.

DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission cancel the pay telephone certificates of Doretta L. Miller, Lorie Shearer & Sharon Anderson and John Collard effective December 31, 1996?

STAFF ANALYSIS: Doretta L. Miller, Lorie Shearer & Sharon Anderson and John Collard complied with Rule 25-24.514(2), Florida Administrative Code, Cancellation of a Certificate, which in pertinent part says that, "if a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request: (a) statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee. (b) statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled."

The above certificate holders did give sufficient notice in writing and submitted their regulatory assessment fee for 1996. Therefore, staff believes that these certificates should be cancelled effective December 31, 1996, so that the certificate holders will not be assessed Regulatory Assessment Fees for the 1997 calendar year.
