Dear Mr. Bowles:

After reviewing your response to the deficiency letter in the above referenced docket, the staff has identified the following deficiencies that still need to be corrected to process the application.

1. In accordance with Rules 25-30.035(9) and 25-30.030(2), Florida Administrative Code, a description of the territory proposed to be served, using township, range and section references is required. Specifically, the following item must be corrected: The second Point of Beginning that references the Northeast Corner of Lot 111 needs to be changed. It must reference a known point such as either a section corner like the Northeast Corner or a subsection corner such as a quarter corner. Please provide a better Point of Beginning. Please provide a copy of the proposed territory description on a 3.5 inch disk in Word Perfect 6.1 for Windows format or other word processing format, if possible. This will prevent any typographical errors when we prepare the recommendation.

2. As required by Rule 25-30.035(11), Florida Administrative Code, the territory map provided does not identify the angles, distances, or points of beginning. Please draw the updated territory description on the map labeling all angles and distances and resubmit. We will then be able to determine if the territory descriptions are correct.

3. As required by Rule 25-30.035(10), Florida Administrative Code, one system map must be provided. Your letter dated January 29, 1997 did not reference a system map that was requested by Ms. Tomlinson in her September 20, 1996 letter. If an as built map is not available, the utility can draw the water and wastewater lines on a suitable map and label the size of the water and wastewater lines, and the plants.

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
