**Re: Assignment of Certificate
Fast Connections, Inc.**

Dear Mr. Williams:

On behalf of Fast Connections, Inc. ("FCI"), we hereby respectfully request the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") to assign FCI's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from FCI to Fast Connections, LP ("FCLP").¹ On January 27, 1997, the Commission granted FCI a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as an alternative local exchange telecommunications company in the State of Florida. See Docket No. 961400-IX.

The officers, directors, and shareholders of FCI are Dan and Gail Patterson (the "Pattersons"). For tax purposes, the Pattersons have decided to conduct their business through a Texas limited partnership, FCLP. The Pattersons will be the limited partners. FC Holdings Inc., a Texas corporation wholly owned by the Pattersons, will be the general partner. Upon Commission approval, the Pattersons will assign FCI's Certificate to FCLP. FCLP will operate in the same manner as FCI.

Following the completion of the merger, FCLP will apply for a certificate of authority to


