NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION
ORDER GRANTING CERTIFICATES TO PROVIDE
INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding in accordance with Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

Each of the entities listed in the caption of this Order filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide interexchange telecommunications service. The respective applications contain the required background information and the proposed tariffs. Having considered these applications, it appears that it is in the public interest to grant, to these entities, certificates to provide interexchange telecommunications service. The entities and certificate numbers are listed below.

Interexchange telecommunications service providers are charged with the responsibility of complying with the provisions of Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 25-4 and 25-24, Florida Administrative Code. Moreover, pursuant to the provisions of Order No. 16804, interexchange telecommunications service providers are prohibited from constructing facilities to bypass a local exchange company without express prior approval from this Commission.

These dockets will be closed following the expiration of the period specified in the Notice of Further Proceedings or Judicial Review section of this Order unless an appropriate petition, protesting a specific application, is filed by one whose substantial interests may or will be affected by this proposed agency action, as provided in Rules 25-22.029 and 25-22.036(7)(a), Florida Administrative Code. A petition protesting a specific application filed by one whose substantial interests are affected will not prevent our proposed action from becoming final as to any other application listed in the caption of this Order.

It is therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that we hereby grant, to each of the applicants listed in the caption of this Order, a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications service subject to the conditions stated in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that each entity shall operate under the corresponding certificate number as listed in the body of this Order. It is further

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ORDERED that any petition protesting any particular application shall not prevent the action proposed herein from becoming final as to any other application listed in the caption of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that, unless a person whose interests are substantially affected by the action proposed herein files a petition in the form and by the date specified in the Notice of Further Proceedings or Judicial Review, the certificates shall become effective on the following date and these dockets shall be closed.
