**RE:** Docket No. 970460-TX, Wireless One Network, L.P., Financial Analysis for Certificate Application for Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications Service

Section 364.337 (1), Florida Statutes, requires the following:

The commission shall grant a certificate of authority to provide alternative local exchange service upon a showing that the applicant has sufficient technical, financial, and managerial capability to provide such service in the geographic area proposed to be served.

Also Section 364.01 (3) and (4) states that:

(3) The Legislature finds that the competitive provision of telecommunications service, including local exchange telecommunications service, is in the public interest.

and

(4)(d) The Commission shall exercise its exclusive jurisdiction in order to: (d) Promote competition by encouraging new entrants into telecommunications markets . . .

Regarding the showing of financial capability, the Finance staff has analyzed the financial statements of Wireless One Network, L.P. (Wireless). Wireless requested and was granted confidentiality for its financial statements.

ACK        In this matter, Wireless is asking for a certificate to provide alternative local exchange telecommunications service. Staff notes the limited nature of the application.

APP        The applicant attests to its financial capability to provide and maintain the proposed  
CAF        telecommunications service by noting that it anticipates its current cellular operations will finance  
CMU        its ALEC start-up, and that it has an available unused line of credit. Based on this showing, the  
CTR        applicant appears to meet the financial capability standard of Section 364.337, Florida Statutes.
