Recommendation: No. The petition should be dismissed.







Issue 2: Should TIHA's Petition to Levy Fine for Failure to Comply with Commission Order, Petition to Establish Wastewater Rates Based Upon Water Consumption Data and Offer to Take Over Facilities be granted?

Recommendation: No. The petition should be dismissed. If the Commission dismisses TIHA's petition to intervene, as recommended in Issue 1, TIHA lacks standing to file the motion. Furthermore, the Commission cannot address matters which exceed the scope of matters specifically authorized by the Court in its relinquishment of jurisdiction to the Commission.

Issue 3: Should Florida Water's motion to dismiss TIHA's petition be granted?

Recommendation: If the Commission dismisses TIHA's petition to intervene and its related motions, a ruling upon Florida Water's motion to dismiss is not necessary.
