Issue A: (Continued)

Alternative Recommendation 1: Yes, the Commission should take additional evidence; however, a hearing is not necessary. The additional staff analyses of the impact on rates should be filed and interested persons given the opportunity to file responses.

Alternative Recommendation 2: No, the Commission should not take additional evidence. The Commission has followed all required rulemaking procedures and interested persons have been given an opportunity to address the Commission and submit information on the impact of the proposed rule and FWA's alternative proposal.

Issue 1: Should the Commission adopt proposed Rule 25-30.431?

Recommendation: Yes, the Commission should adopt proposed Rule 25-30.431, F.A.C., with the changes recommended by staff as shown in Attachment 1 of staff's memorandum dated April 2, 1997.
