DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should Northeast Florida Telephone Company, Inc.'s tariff filing to delete all references to Flat and Message or Measured Rate Service be approved?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. Northeast's tariff filing deleting all references to Flat and Message or Measured Rate Service should be approved, effective July 5, 1997. (O'Pry)

STAFF ANALYSIS: Northeast Florida Telephone Company, Inc.'s (Northeast or the Company) tariff filing, Attachment A -- T-97-503 filed June 5, 1997, seeks authority to delete all references to Flat and Message or Measured Rate Service in its General Subscriber Service Tariff (GSST).

The Company advises that Message or Measured Rate Service has never been offered, nor does Northeast anticipate to offer it in the future. Staff believes it is misleading to continue such language in the tariff and recommends that the deletion be approved.

A2.3 ESTABLISHMENT AND FURNISHING OF SERVICE (Cont'd.)

A2.3.2 ~~Flat and Message Rate Service~~ Reserved For Future Use (T) (D)

~~When both flat and message rate services are offered in an exchange, an applicant may, at his option, select either type of service. A combination of both flat and message rate service will not be furnished on the same premises to the same subscriber, or in the same room to the same subscriber or to a group of different subscribers, except that this does not apply to hotel and hospital premises where flat rate service may be furnished for the exclusive use of the hotel or hospital management or may be contracted for separately by guests or patients in addition to the message service ordinarily provided in guests' or patients' rooms and lobbies; nor to premises where public telephones may properly be located; nor to nonadministrative lines connected to secretarial service facilities and not furnished with outward service; nor to the premises of a Shared Tenant Service client who requests direct service from the Company.~~

A2.3.4 Application for Service

- A. Any applicant for service may be required to sign an application form requesting the Company to furnish the service in accordance with the rates, charges, rules, and regulations from time to time in force and effect.
