COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), and files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5)(c), Florida Administrative Code, its Motion for Temporary Protective Order in connection with its Responses to Office of Public Counsel's ("Public Counsel") Second Set of Post-Settlement Interrogatories (1996 Earnings) dated June 6, 1997.

On June 20, 1997, BellSouth filed its Responses to Public Counsel's Second Set of Post-Settlement Interrogatories (1996 Earnings), portions of which are deemed to be confidential and proprietary by BellSouth.
