Pursuant to Securities and Exchange Commission Rule 53(a)(4), C.F.R. 250.53.(a)(4), Gulf Power Company (Gulf) filed documents with the Florida Public Service Commission on June 4, 1997. Gulf also filed a notice of intent to request confidential classification for these documents. Section 366.093 (3)(e), Florida Statutes, considers proprietary confidential business information to be information relating to competitive interests where the disclosure of the information would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. Staff has reviewed the documents listed below for which Gulf requested confidential classification. Staff believes the documents are within the parameters set by the statute. These documents should be returned to Gulf Power Company's attorneys, who will retain the documents for 5 years.
