- 17.0 * Delinquent Bills - After a bill becomes delinquent, the water service may then, after five days written notice, be discontinued. Service will be resumed only upon payment of all past-due bills and penalties. However, if the Company is called by the customer and requested to pick up the delinquent payment at the service address, or if someone is present at the service address when a Company employee arrives to shut off the water service, then the water service should be left on and a \$10.00 Premise Visit Charge in Lieu of Disconnection be collected in addition to the delinquent amount. If the water service is shut off because no one was at the service location to pay the delinquent amount when the Company employee was there, then to restore water service a Violation Reconnection service charge of \$15.00 is to be collected in addition to the delinquent amount if the work is performed during normal working hours, or if the work is performed after normal working hours, the service charge is \$20.00. For the purposes of this tariff rule, any Violation Reconnection called in or arranged in person at the business office after 4:00 p.m. shall be considered after hours. (See Rule 18.0 also)
- 18.0 * Payment of Water and Private Fire Protection Service Bills Concurrently - When both water and PFP service are provided by the Company, payment of any water service bill rendered by the Company to a water service Consumer shall not be accepted by the Company without the simultaneous or concurrent payment of any PFP service bill rendered by the Company. If the charges for water service are not so paid, the Company may discontinue both PFP service and water service to the Consumer's premises for nonpayment of the water service charges or if the charges for PFP service are not so paid the Company may discontinue both water service and PFP service to the Consumer's premises for nonpayment of the PFP service charge. The Company shall not re-establish or reconnect PFP service and water service or either of such services until such time as all other expenses or charges established or provided for by these rules and regulations are paid.
- * Appropriate fire marshal is to be notified in advance by certified mail before disconnecting a private fire protection customer.
- 19.0 Base Facility Charge - This is the part of the Consumer's monthly bill that is charged whether any water is consumed or not. It is applicable to an owner/customer whether or not there is an occupancy at a service location. This charge was developed to compensate the Utility for certain fixed costs that the utility must pay that are caused by a service location being connected to a water system, regardless of whether or not any water is consumed at the service location.

*The minimum required accuracy for compound meters at any rate within the "changeover" range of flows shall be 85%.

- 29.0 Initial Connection and Normal Reconnection - The Company requires an Initial Connection service charge of \$15.00 if done during normal work hours, and \$20.00 if done after normal work hours to commence initial water service. The Company also requires Normal Reconnection service charges in the amount of \$15.00 to restore water service when it has been discontinued for proper cause.
- 30.0 Worthless Check Service Charge - Company requires a service charge on any bank returned check in amount not to exceed \$25.00 if the face value does not exceed \$50.00, \$30.00 if the face value exceeds \$50.00 but does not exceed \$300.00, \$40.00 if the face value exceeds \$300.00 or an amount of up to 5% of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 832 Florida Statutes.
