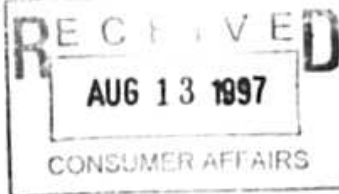

Re: Additional Area Code for Dade County, Fl.

To Whom It May Concern:

Although we fully accept the fact that this area needs an additional area code, we wish to register our objections to the proposed overlay system, as a geographical division seems more sensible over the long term. Most areas have incorporated new codes according to geography, probably for a number of valid reasons. Either system has its own inherent set of difficulties which requires a period of adjustment in time and financial expenditure. However, geographic divisions make cognitive sense; they can be learned, organized in one's mind, drawn on a map. With the overlay, we are permanently stuck with a state of general confusion over both commercial and noncommercial numbers. How can that be in our best interests?

We understand the preference of businesses to avoid the short-term expenditures and confusion while they change phone systems, stationery, and notify customers. We understand some of the reasons for certain telephone companies using the overlay as a strategic planning tool in the competition for a larger market share, just as a geographical division of area codes benefits others. These are not valid reasons to choose the overlay.

Please make the choice for a geographic distribution of area codes. It is an industry standard that works. It makes sense. It is something that we can adjust to. It doesn't throw us into a situation of perpetual confusion and uncertainty.

Thank you seeking the public's opinions on this matter and listening to our concerns. We hope that enough people sharing our opinion will take time to let you know, so that your decision in favor of a geographic distribution will be an easier decision to make.


On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Key West Chamber of Commerce I am writing to protest the implementation of assigning a new additional area code to new businesses and residents in Monroe County.

It is our understanding that any new business or resident establishing phone service in Monroe County after January 1, 1998 will be issued a new area code number as well. We are of the opinion that the problems and confusion this would cause far out way the perceived need. Imagine having to call one area code to reach your home and another to reach your home business line. In our opinion, it would make more sense to allocate one area code to Monroe County and an additional area code to Dade County.

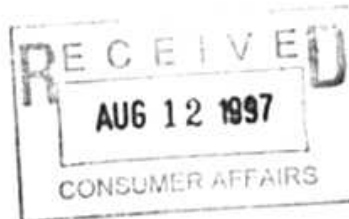
We are also concerned that public opinion on the impact of this decision was not taken into consideration. This seems almost incredible given that nearly 2.5 million Floridians will be affected by this decision. At the very least, a public hearing prior to the June vote should have been conducted.

In summary, the Key West Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors opposes 1) the implementation of assigning a new area code to Monroe County and 2) the implementation of this decision without public opinion.
