However, on its own motion, the Commission should acknowledge that Order No. PSC-96-1137-FOF-WS is currently under appeal and subject to the automatic stay provision in Rule 9.310(b)(2), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, and that the territory addressed in that order includes part of the territory transferred from South Broward Utility, Inc. to Clay Utility Company by Order No. PSC-97-0579-FOF-WS.
