The perimeter shall be described by traversing the proposed territory and closing at the point of beginning. Also, the description shall include all bearings and distances necessary to provide a continuous description.
- References to interstates, state roads, and major bodies of water are acceptable.
- 4) References to government lots, local streets, recorded plats or lots, tracts, or other recorded instruments are not acceptable.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, GRANTING THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD FOR THE CLAY COUNTY UTILITY AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE BY GIFT THE MCRAE LANDING WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM, PURSUANT TO SECTION 6(17) OF CHAPTER 94-491, LAWS OF FLORIDA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the owner of a small water treatment plant and water distribution system operating under Florida Public Service Commission Certificate No. 299-W and known as the McRae Landing Water Treatment Plant and Water Distribution System (the Plant and System), desires to transfer the Plant and System by gift to the Clay County Utility Authority (the CCUA), an independent special district established under Chapter 94-491, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1994 (the Special Act); and,

WHEREAS, Section 6(17) of the Special Act provides: "the [CCUA] is expressly prohibited from purchasing or acquiring by any other means any other water and sewer company without the approval of the Clay County Commission"; and,

WHEREAS, the CCUA desires to acquire by gift the transfer of the Plant and System, and has requested the approval therefor of the Board of County Commissioners of Clay County, Florida, under said Section 6(17) of the Special Act.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To the extent that the provisions of said Section 6(17) or any other provision of the Special Act so requires, the Board of County Commissioners of Clay County, Florida does hereby grant its approval for the CCUA to accept by the gift the transfer of the Plant and System.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
