RE: DOCKET NO. 920199-WS - Application for rate increase in Brevard, Charlotte/Lee, Citrus, Clay, Duval, Highlands, Lake, Marion, Martin, Nassau, Orange, Osceola, Pasco, Putnam, Seminole, Volusia, and Washington Counties by Southern States Utilities, Inc.; Collier County by Marco Shores Utilities (Deltona); Hernando County by Spring Hill Utilities (Deltona); and Volusia County by Deltona Lakes Utilities (Deltona).

Issue 1: Should Florida Water Services be required to provide a revised refund/surcharge report, as discussed in the analysis portion of staff's September 4, 1997 memorandum, within seven calendar days of the Commission vote?

Recommendation: Yes. Florida Water Services should be required to provide a revised refund/surcharge report, as discussed in staff analysis, to all parties by September 16, 1997. FWSC should also be required to file the supporting documentation on computer disc in a format which may be converted to Lotus 1-2-3 by staff. FWSC should be placed on notice that any further variations will not be tolerated, and may result in further proceedings addressing possible penalties. Further, the deadline for all parties to file briefs, as ordered in Order No. PSC-97-1033-PCO-WS, should be extended seven days to October 7, 1997.
