CASE BACKGROUND

On January 24, 1996, the Commission opened this docket to review the dialing patterns associated with the implementation of BellSouth's ECS routes addressed in Order Nos. PSC-95-1391-FOF-TL and PSC-96-0123-FOF-TL. In these orders, the Commission established 7-digit and 10-digit dialing patterns for various ECS routes.

On April 25, 1996, the Commission issued Order No. PSC-96-0558-FOF-TP addressing the specific dialing patterns to be used for each ECS route identified in the previous orders and clarified what the dialing patterns should be for the Southeast LATA. The directives from Order No. PSC-96-0558-FOF-TP are listed below:

1. The Commission required BellSouth to implement 1+10-digit dialing on all routes that were being converted from toll to ECS.
2. BellSouth was to retain 7-digit dialing for all routes, except the lone LCP route in the Southeast LATA, that were being converted from an existing 7-digit calling plan to ECS.

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3. The Commission identified the specific dialing patterns to be implemented for Local, EAS between 561 and 954, EAS between Hollywood and North Dade, and ECS routes.

The Commission kept this docket open to address any problems that may not have been considered in its original decision to implement the dialing patterns discussed above. Although there could be some dialing changes that may be necessary for compliance with the Telecommunication Act of 1996, staff is unaware of any pending problems with the dialing patterns listed above; and therefore, is filing this recommendation to close this docket.
