INTERMEDIA COMMUNICATIONS INC.'S  
REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Intermedia Communications Inc. (Intermedia), hereby files pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Request for Confidential Classification, and states the following:

1. On August 26, 1997, Intermedia filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification in response to the request of the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission to provide Julia Strow's Confidential Late-Filed Deposition Exhibit No. 5 in connection with the above-captioned matter. Such information was provided to Nancy B. White c/o Nancy H. Sims, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. on August 14, 1997.

2. This information was entered into the record as confidential at the hearing and has been identified as part of Exhibit 78.

3. Specifically, staff requested that Intermedia provide a breakdown of local numbers by market area and by NPA/NXX. This information also states the local numbers available, reserved and assigned. This information directly relates to Intermedia's competitive interests. Disclosure of this information would impair the competitive business interests of Intermedia by allowing

competitors to determine the specific markets where Intermedia

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conducts its business and determine the number of customers and volume where Intermedia conducts its business.

4. Attachment "A" to this Request identifies the page and line at which the confidential material is found, and correlates the page and line with the specific justification for confidential classification of the information.

5. Two copies of the information with the confidential information redacted are attached hereto as Attachment "B."

6. One highlighted copy of the information with the material which is confidential and proprietary is attached hereto in a sealed envelope as Attachment "C."

7. The information for which Intermedia seeks confidential classification is not publicly available. Intermedia has treated and intends to continue to treat the material for which confidential classification is sought as private, confidential information and this information has not been disclosed to the public.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, Intermedia Communications Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order declaring that the information described above to be confidential proprietary business information, and thus not subject to public disclosure.

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
