

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: Rule 25-6.0183, F.A.C., should be amended to remove all references to Section 377.703, F.S. The rule must also be reviewed to determine whether it is appropriate for the Commission to refer to and adopt the Reliability Coordinating Council's Generating Capacity Shortage Element of its Florida Electrical Emergency Contingency Plan as the Commission's emergency plan under the grid bill.

SUBJECT AREA TO BE ADDRESSED: The Commission's emergency planning responsibilities under the grid bill for generating capacity shortage emergencies.
