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NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION
ORDER IMPOSING FINE

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

Long Distance Network Services, Inc. (LDNSI or the company), an interexchange telecommunications carrier (IXC), currently holds certificate of public convenience and necessity number 3570, issued by the Commission on August 9, 1994, authorizing the provision of interexchange telecommunications service. This docket was opened to cancel LDNSI's certificate, unless the company paid its delinquent 1996 regulatory assessment fee, which was due by January 31, 1997, along with statutory penalties and interest charges, and a \$500 fine for failure to comply with Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code. 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paid its 1996 regulatory assessment fee, along with the statutory penalties and interest charges, as required by Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code on August 13, 1997. Thus, its certificate shall not be cancelled. The fine, however, shall be levied.

LDNSI shall remit payment of the fine in the amount of \$500 within five business days from the date this Order becomes final. The fine will be transmitted to the Comptroller for deposit in the State of Florida General Revenue Fund, pursuant to Section 364.516, Florida Statutes.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Long Distance Network Services, Inc. shall pay a \$500 fine to the Florida Public Service Commission for failure to comply with Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, within five business days from the date this Order becomes final. The fine shall be transmitted to the Comptroller for deposit in the State of Florida General Revenue Fund. It is further

ORDERED that the provisions of this Order, issued as proposed agency action, shall become final and effective unless an appropriate petition, in the form provided by Rule 25-22.036, Florida Administrative Code, is received by the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, by the close of business on the date set forth in the "Notice of Further Proceedings or Judicial Review" attached hereto. It is further

ORDERED that in the event this Order becomes final, this Docket shall be closed upon payment of the fine.
