

American Communications Services of Jacksonville, Inc. ("ACSI-Jacksonville") through undersigned counsel and pursuant to section 364.183, Florida Statutes and Rule 25-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code, herewith files its Request for Confidential Treatment of portions of Late Filed Hearing Exhibit No. 75.

1. During cross-examination, the Commission Staff requested ACSI witness James Falvey to provide Late-Filed Hearing Exhibit No. 75 identifying number of customers and access lines. ACSI considers such information to be proprietary and confidential but on September 15 ACSI filed the requested exhibit together with a notice that ACSI considered the information confidential and intended to request such treatment.

2. Late-Filed Hearing Exhibit No. 75 identifies the specific number of customers and access lines and it is that information which ACSI considers proprietary and confidential. This information relates to the competitive activity and interest of ACSI. Disclosure of this data would allow competitors to determine market penetration, revenues and business plans and would adversely affect ACSI's business interests.


